Go for a ramble to the Hidden Valley, where rustlers of old used to hide their spoil. Visit Glencoe Folk Museum – here you will discover much about life in the Highlands of bygone days.

Climbers and hill-walkers should be in their element with Ben Nevis and many “Munros” close by. Boat hire, pony trekking and riding are within easy reach and Coastal Cruising and Coach Tours are organised by local operators.

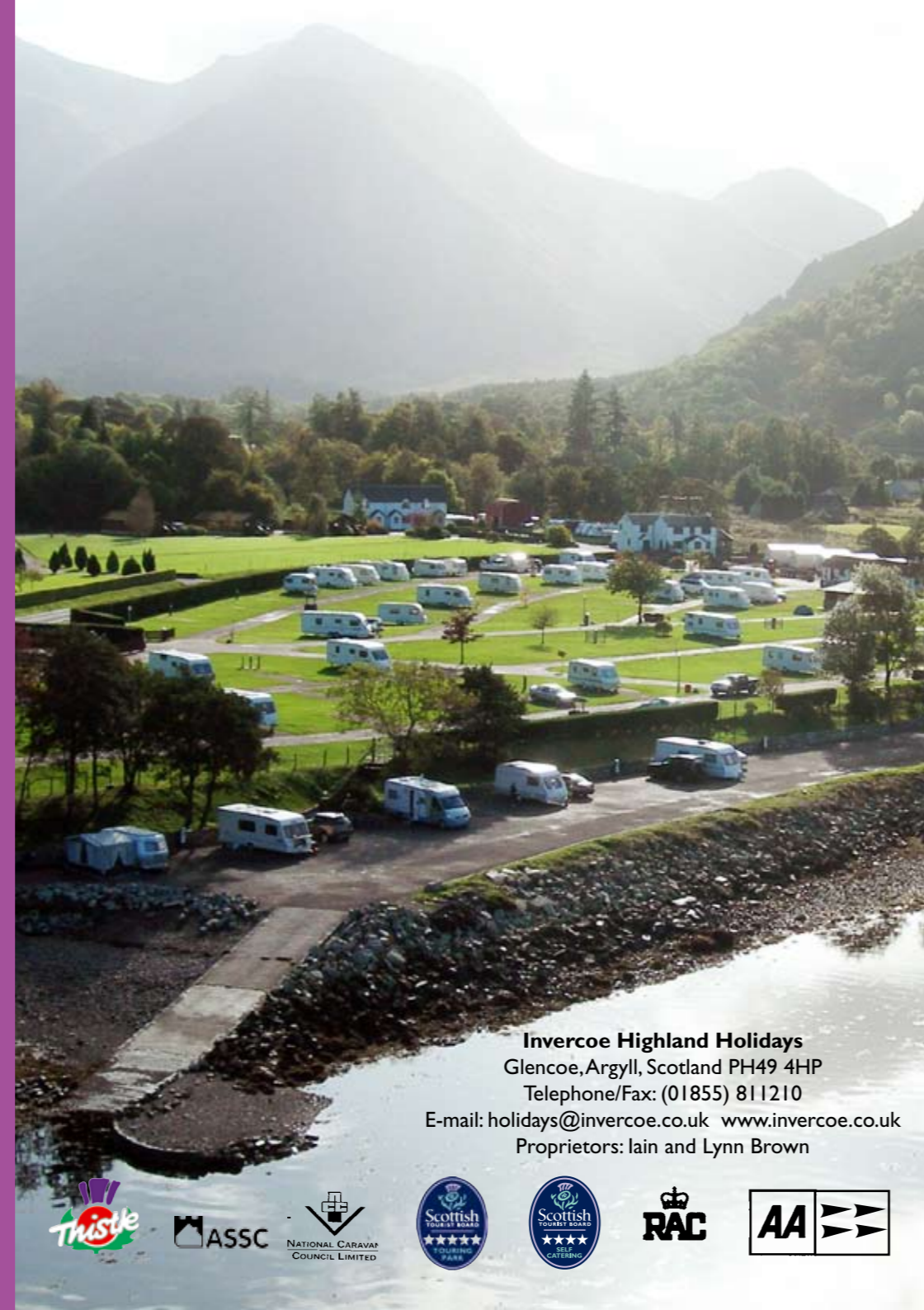
There are also many interesting indoor exhibitions and activities in the area should the weather be less than clement.

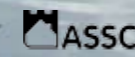

Maclain Cottages

These three cottages have been built to the highest standards on the site of the house of Maclain, clan chief of the MacDonalDs, massacred in 1692.

Each double glazed and centrally heated cottage consists of an entry porch (with adequate space for outdoor gear), an open plan living room/kitchen, sun lounge/dining room and a bathroom on the ground floor with digital combi TV/DVD unit and CD player. Upstairs there are two spacious bedrooms. Free wi-fi when staying in one of our cottages.

The kitchen is fully equipped including cooker, fridge/freezer, washing machine/drier, microwave and integrated dishwasher.



Touring Caravan & Camping Park

Our long established caravan and camping park offers a high standard holiday with our Park achieving a Five Star top grading by VisitScotland.

It is surrounded by beautiful scenery with grassy level pitches and some hard standing areas, so bring your caravan, motorhome or tent for a fabulous, relaxing stay in Glencoe.
